



China energy storage demonstration power station

As of September 8, the construction of the project's rooftop distributed solar station, energy storage station, regenerative electric boiler, and electric power supporting facilities has been completed. The construction of two DC charging stations and two AC charging stations has begun, and is planned to be completed by the end of September.

On May 24, the 220kV Chunan Line and Chuwan Line were successfully connected and The 100MW/400MWh Redox Flow Battery Storage Demonstration Project was successfully connected to the Dalian grid. This marks that the demonstration project is officially online and connected after 6 years of planning, co

The first phase of the 10MW demonstration power station passed the grid connection acceptance and was officially connected to the grid for power generation.
