

# Energy storage battery starts production in japan

Why are battery storage projects growing in Japan?

The ramp up of battery storage projects in Japan continues apace, aided by growing subsidy avenues and rising volumes on various electricity markets, from spot to balancing to capacity.

Where are Panasonic Batteries made?

Osaka, Japan, November 20, 2023 - Panasonic Energy Co., Ltd., a Panasonic Group Company, announced that the company completed a project to relocate its dry battery factory and that the Nishikinohama Factory (Kaizuka City, Osaka) today launched full-scale production of AA, AAA, C, and D alkaline batteries.

Can EV batteries be reused in Japan?

One feature of our grid energy storage system is that it utilizes reused batteries from EVs. Although the penetration rate of EVs in Japan is still only about 1%, the Japanese government aims for 100% of all new passenger car sales to be EVs by 2035. This, at the same time, means that more batteries will be discarded.

Will battery storage be a key technology?

This means battery storage will be a key technology, along with industrial demand response and aggregated virtual power plants (VPPs), in managing volatility on the country's electricity grids. There are also newly introduced low-carbon capacity market auctions.

Why do we use Panasonic Batteries?

Japan, which targets renewable energy representing 36% to 38% of the electricity mix by 2030 and 50% by 2050, is seeking to promote energy storage technologies as an enabler of that goal. At the same time, electricity demand forecasts for the coming years have risen due to the expected increased adoption of AI and

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the growth of data centres.

Over a gigawatt of bids from battery storage project developers have been successful in the first-ever competitive auctions for low-carbon energy capacity held in Japan. A total 1.67GW of projects won contracts, including 32 battery energy storage system (BESS) totalling 1.1GW and three pumped hydro energy storage (PHES) projects totalling 577MW.
