The method of charging up the 22 mF energy storage capacitor using a boost converter takes 51.57 s to reach 0.17 V while the proposed method only requires 4.53 s, which is over 91% faster. With the same time duration of 51.57 s, the proposed circuit has already charged the capacitor to 0.71 V, which is over 317% higher than the conventional ...

Energy Storage in Capacitors (contd.) $\frac{1}{2} C V^2$ It shows that the energy stored within a capacitor is proportional to the product of its capacitance and the squared value of the voltage across the capacitor. o

Recall that we also can determine the stored energy from the fields within the dielectric: $W = \frac{1}{2} \int_V \epsilon E^2 dV$ volume
