

# Energy storage cell project investment

Will battery energy storage investment hit a record high in 2023?

After solid growth in 2022, battery energy storage investment is expected to hit another record high and exceed USD35 billion in 2023, based on the existing pipeline of projects and new capacity targets set by governments.

Why do energy storage projects need project financing?

The rapid growth in the energy storage market is similarly driving demand for project financing. The general principles of project finance that apply to the financing of solar and wind projects also apply to energy storage projects.

How big will energy storage capacity be in 2022?

An estimated 387 gigawatts (GW) (or 1,143 gigawatt hours (GWh)) of new energy storage capacity is expected to be added globally from 2022 to 2030, which would result in the size of global energy storage capacity increasing by 15 times compared to the end of 2021.

What do we expect in the energy storage industry this year?

This report highlights the most noteworthy developments we expect in the energy storage industry this year. Prices: Both lithium-ion battery pack and energy storage system prices are expected to fall again in 2024.

Which energy storage technologies are included in the 2020 cost and performance assessment?
