A typical household may consume 3,500 kWh of electricity per year and a typical solar array may generate

2,800kWh in that time. Of this, the household may use 30% with the rest being exported to the grid. With a 6kWh battery the household may now be able to use 70% of the solar generated energy - more than twice as much.
