MLG has historically been associated with console shooters such as the Halo and Call of Duty series, but it has recently added PC games such as Dota 2, Starcraft II, and Counter-Strike: Global Offensive.

Major League Gaming Corp.(MLG) is a professional esports organization. MLG is headquartered in New York City, New York and was founded in 2002 by Sundance DiGiovanni and Mike Sepso. MLG has held official video game tournaments throughout the United States and Canada.

What is the MLG Pro League?

The MLG Pro League was a Call of Duty league that ran in 2014 and 2015 for Ghosts and Advanced Warfare respectively. There were three seasons per year, and 16 teams competing per season. The regular season was played online in a round-robin tournament format over the course of two months.
