Compared to classic overdriven SG tones, the G-400's midrange output is a little subdued, and you get less of the deep, throaty snarl you associate with a classic SG. Still, the G-400 PRO is excellent for low-gain blues leads, growling classic rock rhythms, and even aggressive modern rock and metal.
